NORTH CLACKAMAS FALL BALL RULES AND EXPECTATIONS

Rules - NCFB follows JBO American Rules. Pitchers are limited to 3 innings per game. Bring a rule book with you to your game if you have one.

Game Dates: Fall ball is 9 weeks long and runs August 28 thru October 30. There are no games on Labor Day weekend.

Game length - 9 innings or 2 hours, whichever comes first. No new inning will start with less than 10 minutes to play.

Game Locations – All games will be played at North Clackamas Park. Game Schedules list what field you play on.

Arrival Times - No team may arrive prior to 8:30am on any game day. This applies to all games starting at 9am or later. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Warm-ups – There will be no infield warm-ups prior to game start

Home Team – A coin toss at the beginning of each game determines the home team.

Baseballs – Game balls will be provided for all of your games.

Expectations - Be respectful to umpires, players, coaches and spectators. The rules and expectations are broad in nature; please let good judgment and sportsmanship dictate the actions of you and your team. Coaches should use Fall Ball as a development opportunity when possible. **Teams should register at the level they will play in the spring of 2012.** Example if your played at the Junior level and your team consisted of mostly 6th graders and your team will play Seniors the following year you should sign up to play at the Senior level for fall ball. **If you have a player entering high school in the fall they are not eligible to participate in North Clackamas Fall Ball.**

No Smoking – Smoking is prohibited at games.

Insurance – All teams must provide certificates of insurance naming MJBA, PYB and NCP as additionally insured. Proof must be submitted to registrar prior to first game. If you need more information, contact the registrar.

Standings – There will be no standings or trophies at the end of the season.

Rainout Refunds – If you play 5 or more games there will be no refunds. The rainout line is 503-742-4343.
