**State Report:**

- 1) Proposal that requires all person who wish to coach or officiate must pass a Federal Background check. This review will need to be completed at association level.
- 2) Possible increase in team fees, where the upfront fee will be paid at the beginning of the season and teams making Championship games will not have to pay a fee at the tournament.
- 3) Proposal that teams must have a 12 man roster any player missing without a written excuse will be considered an out at bat.
- 4) Proposal to add an extra inning for pitching in 2 consecutive games
- 5) Proposal to make Federal play at all levels an open division and to follow a hard matrix with American and National level
- 6) Proposal to follow College & High School Bat Regulations by 2013.
- 7) Cub level play to be managed by Clackamas County Jr. Baseball and JBO will host Championship Games.
